The Scottsdale School Board has approved a fee (actual cost) for elementary extracurricular activities. The Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S. 43-1089.01) now provide that taxpayers may receive a tax credit up to \$200 for single filers and \$400 for married filers the payment of extracurricular fees. In general, extracurricular activities are any optional, noncredit, educational or recreational activity which supplement the educational program of the school, whether offered before, during or after the regular school hours (A.R.S. 15-342). In order for the school to process a receipt so you can claim the fee as a tax credit, please supply the school with the following information:
